At CPAA, it's more than just dance.

Class Information

CPAA is a traditional dance school with a progressive format. Our classroom is a positive environment that encourages learning through exploration of movement, teamwork, and creativity. Our classes are high energy and fun for all ages! Our structure allows dancers to form friendships and create healthy habits while promoting self-confidence.

Shoe & Attire Requirements

All students are required to dress properly for class. Dancers' hair should be pulled back a way from face for *all* dance classes. Students who do not follow the dress attire requirements will not be able to participate in class. **Dance shoes should not be worn outside the studio.** Street shoes should be removed and placed on the shoerack as soon the student enters the studio. **PLEASE label all shoes and dance items with first and last name**. A list of required attire is below.

Spirit Attire

It is important that students represent CPAA Dance Company/Kidz Crew with a uniform look at competitions/conventions and events. Students are required to purchase and maintain spirit attire for this purpose. An order form for the required warmups will be emailed to you no later than October 15th.

Competition/Performance Costumes and Hair

Students are required to purchase costumes for each competition routine in which they participate. Costumes are an important part of competitions. We have a talented and qualified seamstress who will design our costumes. Costs associated with costumes are for designs, labor, material, embellishments, fittings, and alterations. The average costs of this year's costumes are \$250. This price includes accessories. Tights and shoes are not included in the costume fee and are the responsibility of the parent. Student's dance wardrobe should include a black CPAA tank top and as well as black dance shorts and leggings for events and performances. An order form for the required tank top will be emailed to you no later than October 15th.

Hair styles for each competition routine will be determined by the choreographer. You will be notified of this hairstyle prior to the first competition.

Measurements

Students' measurements for costumes are tentatively scheduled for the 1st week of classes. Please make every effort to have your dancer present. If a student misses measurement day, it is your responsibility to make sure we get measurements before costumes are ordered. Growth consideration is given to all measurements. Parents will receive costumes a couple of weeks before our first competition. You will be required to acknowledge receipt of your student's costume(s) with your signature.

Arrival & Departure

Students should arrive 10 minutes before class eager and ready to learn. Students should be dropped off curb side. It is expected that parents are punctual and have their student arrive to on time. Arriving late disrupts the flow of dance class and distracts students. Excessive tardiness will not be allowed.

Students will be escorted outside for curbside pick-up. Please place a name tag with your student's name in large print in your car window. This will expedite pickup. It is imperative that each student is picked up on time. If a student's ride is going to be late due to unavoidable circum stances, the office must be notified as soon as possible. The student will remain in a designated indoor area (breakroom) until he/she is picked up.

Parents, caregivers, and siblings will not be allowed in the studio.

No student is to leave the studio without parent supervision. This includes during any breaks the student may have between classes. Students who leave the studio unsupervised are solely responsible for themselves.

Technique Class Absences

If a student misses a technique class, it must be made up within one month of the date missed in a similar dance class. All Classes cancelled because of an instructor absence will be made up. There is no tuition deduction for classes missed for any reason including vacation, illness, etc.

Rehearsals Absences

Students are allowed three (3) class absences per semester (Semester 1: August – December / Semester 2: January – June). If a student has a school event that interferes with rehearsal or technique classes, they are required to bring a note from the school indicating the event is mandatory. Students missing rehearsals may require a private to go over the dances they missed. Privates are an additional cost. Excessive absences from technique classes and rehearsals may result in immediate dismissal from Company/Kidz Crew. Students dismissed from Company/Kidz Crew will not be allowed to audition the following year.

Technique classes and rehearsals are MANDATORY the week prior to a convention/competition. In cases of emergencies, please notify your teacher immediately if you cannot attend class and/or rehearsals the week before a competition. This will allow your teacher to adjust the class/rehearsal schedule, i.e., running competition dances on the last day the student will be in class.

Absences from Competition/Conventions

Students are not allowed to miss scheduled competitions and conventions. Emergency situations (death in immediate family, hospitalized illness, injury that prevents dancing) will be handled on an individual basis. Competition fees are **NOT REFUNDABLE** even in the event of an emergency. Absence for any other reason will result in immediate dismissal from the Dance Company or a \$750 fine. Any dancer dismissed from the CPAA Dance Company/Kid Crew will not be allowed to audition the following year. The disciplinary action taken will be decided by the Director.

Class Behavior

It is expected that all dancers behave with a level of self-control and respect that is appropriate for their age. Students will be verbally corrected when necessary. If a behavioral problem persists after 2 teacher warnings, students under 7 years old will be a sked to sit for a five-minute time out. Students 8 years and over will be a sked to leave the classroom and call a parent to be picked up. **Disrespect to teachers and/or students will not be tolerated.**

Accounts and Fees

Student Accounts/Billing

- All tuition and dance related fees should be paid on time. If you have a credit card on file, all outstanding balances will be charged on the 3rd of each month.
- There is no additional charge when there are five lessons in a month, and no discount when there are three. Tuition is an annual charge divided by 10 months, not by the class or number of classes in a month.
- We do not have make-up classes for studio closings.
- Tuition remains the same regardless of student absences. Students may schedule a make-up through the studio office.
- Tuition will only be prorated for new students enrolling in classes a fter the registration period.

Refunds

Competing with CPAA is a year-long commitment. All fees are nonrefundable. Depending on circumstances, a credit may be applied to your account. Credits are applied at the Director's discretion.

Tuition

Tuition is due the 1st day of your first class and the 1st of each month thereafter. Your statement will be emailed the week before the due date. Please make sure we have your correct email address on file. If tuition is not paid by the 5th of the month, your account will be accessed a \$35.00 late fee. **Students with an outstanding balance on the 5th of the month will not be allowed to attend class until the balance is paid in full.** Excessive a bsences due to late payments may result in dismissal from the CPAA Dance Company/Kidz Crew.

A \$25.00 NSF fee will be assessed for any returned checks or declined electronic funds.

Due to CDC regulations and social distancing, you will not be able to pay your tuition in the studio. Please pay tuition via our website. If this is not possible, please place your tuition payment in an envelope with your name and hand it to the CPAA staff member as they greet your child. All tuition fees must be paid on time and are non-refundable.

Discounts

A 10% tuition only discount will be given to families with multiple children. The discount will be applied to the student(s) with the lowest tuition.

Fines

All fees associated with being a member of Company and Kidz Crew are included in your monthly tuition except for those items mentioned in your Tuition Agreement and late arrival fines. There will be a late fee added to your account if your dancer is late for his/her call time at competitions. All dancers are to arrive on time at the venue DRESSED and ready to perform. This includes hair and make-up. You have a 15 minute "grace period" to get to the venue without consequences. If you are 15 minutes late, you will be fined \$50. If you are 30 minutes late, you will be fined \$100. Every 15 minutes after that will result in an additional \$50 per 15-minute fine. All fines must be paid within 7 days, or your child will not be able to participate in technique classes. Excessive tardiness may result in dismissal from the competition team.

Spring Recital

Dress Rehearsal and Recital Day

Our 2022 Recital will be held on June 3rd, at Gaston Christian School. We will have more information about the recital at the beginning of the year.

Recital Costume Fees (Kidz Crew ONLY)

All members of Kidz Crew are required to participate in an additional dance for the recital. Each child will be assessed a costume fee of \$150 for a recital dance. This fee is included in your monthly tuition and is non-refundable.

Closing Number

All dancers participate in a closing number at the spring recital. There is a \$30.00 fee for the closing number outfit which will consist of a CPAA t-shirt and a pair of CPAA shorts. The closing number outfit is included in your tuition and is non-refundable

Awards

Awards are given at the spring recital. Students who are celebrating their 5th and 10th year with CPAA will receive a trophy. All other students will receive a medal.

Competitions/Conventions/Performances

Competition Dances

Competition dances are selected based on auditions and the number of dances specified on the Audition Questionnaire you completed the week of auditions. Your dancer may not be selected for the number of dances you indicated but will not be selected for more than indicated.

Performance Opportunities

The CPAA Dance Company/Kidz Crew are often a sked to perform throughout Charlotte and surrounding areas. All dancers are expected to participate in all performances.

Regional Competitions/Conventions

The Dance Company will participate in THREE Regional conventions/competitions and ONE National conventions/competition this year. Kidz Crew will participate in THREE regional competitions. **Competition schedules are not posted until the week before the competition.**

Competitions/Conventions

During competitions/conventions, dancers are required to take classes taught by master instructors in addition to competing their dances. A typical schedule would include solos, duets, trios and/or group dances on Friday starting as early as 8:00 am. Classes on Saturday from 9 am – 3 pm and competition from 4 – 11 pm. Classes on Sunday are from 8:30 am – 3:30 pm followed by a closing show. Typically, there is no competing on Sunday. Scholarships are awarded during the closing show. Please note, we may also be asked to perform at the final show. All students are required to stay until the end of the final show. **Competition/Convention schedules are not posted until the week before the competition.** Convention fees for classes as well as entry fees for competition are included in your monthly tuition. **Due to COVID-19**, there may be several changes to the layout of competitions/conventions. Please be patient and understanding. Remember you are always representing CPAA.

National Competitions

National competitions/conventions are generally held during the summer months and are a required commitment for all dancers. Company and Kidz Crew attend Nationals every other year. This year we have added nationals to the schedule for Company. Dancers are required to attend all rehearsals before the National event.

Private Instruction/Solo Performances

Private dance instruction is an important part of a dancer's growth and development. Spending one on one time with a CPAA dance teacher gives students the attention needed to hone in on specific skills and develop stronger technique through personalized corrections. Private instruction is a vailable to all competitive dancers. Plea se contact your dance teacher for availability and rates.

Students wanting to compete a solo during the dance season and/or at the spring recital must have weekly privates with a CPAA instructor. The decision to perform a solo must be made at the beginning of the dance season. Students may request private instruction at any time during the season, however solo choreography will only be offered to students starting privates at the beginning of the dance season.

We encourage students to learn from as many dance instructors as possible. Students wanting to get solo choreography from a non CPAA choreographer, must get choreographer approval from Siara Fuller. Students getting solo choreography from a non CPAA choreographer are still required to take weekly privates with a CPAA instructor.

The Dance Experience

The lack of diversity in the dance world is one of the most discussed topics in the industry. Among the top competitions and conventions, there are very few African American instructors. We believe if dancers don't see someone reflective of themselves, they will start to believe that making their dreams come true in the dance industry may not be impossible. CPAA wants to change that view. There are tons of successful African American dancers in the industry, and we want to introduce them to you. We will get to know some of these African American performers, choreographers, and instructors by inviting them to spend a weekend with us. We are tentatively scheduling this event for November 18-20, 2022. This weekend experience is mandatory for both Company and Kidz Crew.

Dance Performance

Dancers are required to give 100% during rehearsals and performances. If dancers are not always giving 100%, they may be removed from the dance and the dance will be re-blocked. If a dancer is removed from a dance for any reason, parents are still responsible for costume fees.

General Studio Information

Customer Portal

All active families with a valid email address on file with the studio may access their account detail at any time via the CPAA Customer Portal. First time users must enter the email address they provided a tregistration and click on the "I don't know my password' link. A temporary password will be emailed to you immediately, so you can access the portal. The portal allows you to update contact and student information, register for classes, email us, change your password, etc. The Customer Portal Login link is in the bottom right corner of the Home page on our website.

Studio Rules

- No food or drink (except water) is allowed inside the Dance rooms
- We are a peanut/tree nut free facility; however, CPAA cannot guarantee that the studio will be free of any food allergens including but not limited to all nuts, peanuts, tree nuts, and/or nut products.
- No street shoes are allowed on dance floors.
- No dance shoes should be worn outside of the studio.
- All parents and dancers are always expected to behave in a respectful manner.

Communication

Communication is very important. **Please check your email regularly for important correspondence.** Please make sure we have your correct email address on file, so you don't miss any announcements.

Code of Conduct

Every dancer participating in the CPAA Dance Company must sign our Code of Conduct/Commitment Agreement at the beginning of each dance season.

CPAA Big Sister/Brother Program

Every year, each dancer is partnered with a nother dancer for the dance season. The purpose of the "Dancer 2 Dancer" program is to help guide each other through classes, competitions/conventions, recitals, and to just be there for each other. Being a part of a competitive team can be overwhelming, so each dancer should be there to support each other, help each other and to celebrate each other's successes together. Think of fun and creative ways to show your dance partner that you're thinking a bout him/her throughout the 2022-2023 dance season! You will get your partner at the beginning of September.

Break Room

The break room is there for dancers. All dancers should clean up after themselves. Any dancer not doing so will not be allowed to use the break room. All food and drinks must be consumed in the break room. No food or drinks (except water) is allowed in the lobby or dance rooms. There will be no horseplay or acrobatics in the break room. All dancing should be done in the dance rooms. All dancers not a biding by the rules of the break room will not be allowed to use it.

Inclement Weather

In case of inclement weather, please call the studio to retrieve information left on our outgoing voicemail. You may also check our website and social media pages as they will be updated to reflect closings. All closing announcements will be made in a timely manner. Classes cancelled due to inclement weather are not made up.

Lost & Found

Items left at the studio are placed in our Lost & Found bin located on top of the cubbies in the back of the studio. About four times per year we will donate unclaimed items to a local charity. About a week prior to donation time, we'll send an email reminding you to remind your student to check for any missing items before they are donated.

Summer

We offer a variety of dance camps and classes in June and July. Registration opens in April.

The best form of communication with our instructors is email. Please do not try to catch your instructor between classes.
